**GENERAL POOL RULES FOR STANDARD SUBDIVISION POOLS**

*Rules may vary from pool to pool depending on design of pool and individual BOD requests.*

*All pools should have specific rules posted at the pool.*

1. No running or rough play.
2. No glass containers or alcoholic beverages allowed in pool area.
3. No diving in shallow end of pool (less than 6 feet).
4. Only small floating items, upon pool manager's discretion, will be allowed in the pool.
5. Only one person allowed on diving board at one time.
6. All swimmers must dive straight out and not off to the side of the diving boards, then quickly get out of the deep end.
7. No pets are permitted on the pool premises.
8. Proper swimming attire required.
9. Lifeguards are responsible for all swimmers in both pools; however, all non-swimming children must be primarily supervised by a parent or guardian within arm's reach.
10. There will be a ten minute maintenance and guard break every hour:
  - a. In a one-guard pool ALL swimmers will be out of the water.
  - b. In a multi-guard pool ALL swimmers under 18 years of age will be out of the water.
  - c. The baby/wading pool must be vacated during this break.
11. The use of cocoa butter, baby oil, and other heavy suntan oils causes filter damage. It is advised that these lotions not be permitted in the pool.
12. Members who have guests must sign them in and be responsible for them at all times. It is advised that no more than three (3) guests be allowed per member.
13. A ten (10) minute "Safety Break" will be called for ten minutes every hour, by the lifeguard. During this period, all swimmers must exit all bodies of water.
14. All children under 12 years of age must be accompanied by an adult at least 18 years of age.
  - a. All non-swimmers must be accompanied by a parent or guardian over 18 years of age.
  - b. All non-swimming children must be within arms length of parent or guardian at all times.
15. No swimming after designated swimming hours, unless special arrangements have been made through the management company of the Board of Directors.
16. Voluntary breath holding exercises or contests is strictly prohibited.
17. No loud music around the pool area.
18. Lifeguard has the final authority on interpretation of rules.
19. Lifeguard's primary responsibility is to ensure safety and perform direct supervision of patrons in the pool. This responsibility precedes over general maintenance duties.
